



Founding Reputation




BIFMA is best known in the industry as the *definitive source* of industry furniture standards that measure the safety, durability and sustainability performance.

Simplify standard

- Reduce credits while meeting market demands
- Focus on sustainable results and outcomes versus participation

Align with ESG where appropriate

- Specifically, environment and social reporting metrics
 Maintain a reasonable entry level for small & newcomers
 Ensure e3 2024 maintains alignment with industry demand
 - Chemical data collection, assessment, optimization
 - Embodied carbon calculations
 - Circular economy practices

Provide greater clarity in certification levels

- LEVEL 1 signals a minimum achievement of X
- LEVEL 2 signals achieving a minimum Y
- LEVEL 3 signals achieving a minimum Z

Industry Wide Chemical & Environmental Data Collection

Solve for Two Needs

- 1. Baseline data for an industry wide carbon response
- 2. Material chemical disclosure from suppliers
