





Key similarities | EUDR & Lacey Act



Key differences | EUDR & Lacey Act

Aspect	Lacey Act	EUDR
Focus	Legal harvest and importation	Deforestation-free and legality
Scope	Broad (all plant products)	Targeted (specific high-risk commodities)
Declaration	PPQ 505 - Filed at customs	Due diligence statement required before market entry
Traceability	Country-level sourcing	Geo-location of land of production required
Primary Concern	Compliance with source country laws	Preventing deforestation







EUDR European Deforestation Regulation

Prohibits products that are associated with deforestation and forest degradation, and which have not been produced according to the relevant laws of the country of production.

Mandatory Due Diligence System


Collection of GPS coordinates for harvesting

Documentation to demonstrate compliance and risk mitigation

Submittal of due diligence statements (DDS) to official registry

EUDR with Qarma
